Submit stories between September 21st and October 9th in the red box at the Agawam Public Library. On a separate page, but attached to the story, include the author’s name, grade, school, phone number and parent’s email address.

Winners will be notified by October 16th. The winning stories will be read at the “Star, Serenade and Stone Soup” Candlelight Evening at the Thomas Smith House, 251 North West St. on Friday evening October 23rd from 6-8 P.M.

In cooperation with the Agawam School Department, contest rules will be available to all students in grades 3 through 6 in their respective schools.
